Course in Andrological endocrinology

On behalf of Danish Andrological Society (DAS), Swedish Andrological Society (SAF), and the research collaboration "ReproHigh" the Department of Growth and Reproduction, Rigshospitalet, holds a postgraduate course in Andrological Endocrinology.

The course will take place:

January 22-24, 2014 at Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen, Denmark.

Target group:

Clinicians (endocrinologists, urologists, andrologists, paediatricians, gynaecologists, general practitioners) and researchers with interest in Andrology. Maximum 50 participants.

Curriculum:

2½ days course in andrological endocrinology focusing on androgens and their effect as well as indications for replacement therapy. Seminars based on lectures combined with case presentations. Written examination at the end of the course.
